Glamour, of course! But fashion is also an industry that produces 4 billion tonnes of CO2 equivalent per year, yet never ceases to inspire.

Long after *Sex and the City*, in the year 2024, several series dedicated to the great couturiers - Balenciaga, Christian Dior, Karl Lagerfeld - are hitting the platforms and finding their audience. But in the world of TV shows, fashion is not just a theme: the role of costume also deserves to be questioned, for what it brings to the story and also for the influence it can have in return, in real life.

The Rencontres du Havre sur les séries take an original approach: by ensuring the continuation of cinema through other means, series play a part in artistic creation and, as such, deserve to be analyzed, contextualized and compared, both by the professionals who create them, and by those from civil life concerned by the annual theme.

For this 9<sup>th</sup> session, we'll be joined by Marie Christine Watrin, knitwear product manager for Lagerfeld, Lanvin, Saint Laurent and perhaps Jean-Paul Gaultier! Producers, directors and costume designers will talk about their work on *Becoming Karl Lagerfeld* or *Louis 28*, researchers and journalists will analyze how a fashion designer can become a fictional character, and musicians from Le Havre, rappers Brav and Proof, have invited actors and stylists to talk about the fashion they love...

Of course, there will be no market or competition, but meetings, screenings, conferences, debates, an eloquence contest, another on the creation of pilots, a look back at serial heritage and a focus on educational issues will encourage us to continue dreaming, as well as questioning ourselves about the world of *Falbalas* (Jacques Becker, 1944).

Organized by the Havre de cinéma association, these open days take place at the Oscar Niemeyer library, the Studio cinema and the Arthur Honegger Conservatory.
